

Mathematics & Numeracy

Numeracy

- count forward and backwards 0-20 (and beyond) in Gaelic
- find missing number
- count collections
- make finger patterns
- count objects using one to one correspondence and recognise number patterns.
- identify the number before and the number after a given number
- listen to and copy a rhythm to count the beats
- recognise domino patterns and random arrays quickly

Shape

Learn about different 2D and 3D shapes, sort and describe them

Pattern

Spot and explore patterns (shape, colour and number)

Gaelic and emerging literacy

Listening & Talking -

- Gain confidence sharing experiences and feelings
- Build on new words and phrases in Gaelic and using this in conversation, stories and through drama
- Learning and retelling stories daily
- Sing songs and learn rhymes

Writing

- begin to record experiences and stories
- explore interesting materials for writing and ways to record my experiences
- Use ideas from stories I know to create my own stories (foundations of writing, story mapping, helicopter stories)

Reading

- share my thoughts and feelings about characters and events in stories I read
