



Literacy: Learning Intentions	Use of Gàidhlig language/Tips for you
<p>1. Is urrainn dhomh làithean na seachdain a ràdh ann an òrdugh <i>I can say the days of the week in order</i></p> <p>2. Is urrainn dhomh a ràdh cò ris a tha an t-sìde coltach <i>I can say what the weather is like</i></p> <p>3. Is urrainn dhomh òran na h-aibidil a sheinn <i>I can sing the Gàidhlig alphabet</i></p> <p>4. Is urrainn dhomh am fuaim ùr ‘e’ aithneachadh <i>I can recognise the new sound ‘e’</i></p> <p>5. Is urrainn dhomh facail le ‘e’ a lorg <i>I can find Gàidhlig words associated with the sound ‘e’.</i></p> <p>6. Is urrainn dhomh an litir ‘e’ a sgrìobhadh <i>I can write this sound on my white-board</i></p>	<p>2. Using the learner’s jotter, ask them to draw pictures of words that are associated with the sound ‘e’. You could use a Gaelic book to spot words or the pictures we have made below.</p> <p><b>SEE PICTURE 1</b> See how many words you can find</p> <p><b>6.SEE PICTURE 2</b> for letter formation Practise writing the letter ‘e’ on your whiteboard</p>



Numeracy: Learning Intentions	Use of Gàildhig language/Tips for you
<p>1. Is urrainn dhomh àireamhan air thuaiream aithneachadh <i>I can recognise numerals randomly arranged (6.2.4)</i></p> <p>2. Is urrainn dhomh àireamhan a bhriseadh sìos <i>I can partition domino patterns (6.4.3)</i></p> <p>3. Is urrainn dhomh diofar rudan a chur air dòigh ann am buidhnean co-ionnan <i>I can organise different objects into equal groups (6.6.3)</i></p> <p>4. Is urrainn dhomh 1sg, 2sg agus 5sg a chur ris gus 10sg a dhèanamh gu h-iomlan <i>I can add 1p, 2p and 5p to make a total of 10p (topic)</i></p>	<p>1. Write on small pieces of paper the numbers 0-20. Place out a selection of these randomly and point to each number and ask learners, "What number is this?" (dè an àireamh a tha seo?)</p> <p>2. Draw a domino pattern on the whiteboard, (eg; an 8 domino pattern) ask the learner "how many dots are there?" (Cia mheud spot a th' ann?) Point to four dots on the pattern and point to another 4 dots. Ask how many groups of 4 can they see? (Cia mheud buidheann de ceithir a th' ann?). Then ask the learner to make the groups using a white board pen. Point to 2 dots in the pattern and then another 2, ask learner "how many groups of 2 can you see?" (cia mheud buidheann de dhà a th'ann?) <b>SEE PICTURE 1</b> Repeat this for a domino pattern of 7, 9 and 10</p> <p>3. Using different objects in the home, place out a number of items (eg; 8). Ask the learner to put the objects into twos (dèan buidhnean de dhà) Repeat this using 9 objects and ask learner to put them into groups of 3 (dèan buidhnean de trì), and using 12 objects into groups four (dèan buidhnean de ceithir) <b>SEE PICTURE 2 a, b, c</b></p> <p>4. <a href="https://www.topmarks.co.uk/money/coins-game">https://www.topmarks.co.uk/money/coins-game</a> Click on link, choose counting, then choose 1p to 10p.</p>
